COVID-19 Tour Visitor Guidelines

The Home Builders Association of Lane County is committed to helping protect the health and safety of everyone who visits the 2020 Tour of Homes. We ask that you comply with the following requirements during your visit to any Tour home.

- Tour homes will be limited to a maximum capacity of 1 person per 150 square feet, with a maximum capacity of 25 people regardless of the home's size. You may experience a wait to get in, especially on weekends at popular homes.
- Visitors will not be permitted to approach the front door until the party ahead of them has entered the home.
- Masks or face coverings are required at all times.
- Tour homes will require the use of foot booties and will provide them for your use. Foot booties may not be recycled for others to use. Instead, take them with you and reuse at other Tour homes you visit.
- All visitors must maintain 6' of physical separation between themselves and those they do not live with. Avoid passing others in hallways and on stairs.
- Some small rooms such as closets and bathrooms may be roped off.
- Doors will be left open so that door handles do not need to be touched.
- Visitors are asked not to touch door handles, cabinet pulls, light switches, plumbing fixtures, countertops or other surfaces. Surfaces will be disinfected regularly.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at all homes.
- Visitors must exit through the garage to avoid coming into close contact with other visitors entering the home at the front door.
- Do not visit Tour homes if you are sick or are at risk for severe complications. Do not enter if you don't feel safe or comfortable.
- Due to the current circumstances, we do not encourage children attending the tour.
